

At the State Championship tournament prior to nationals held at Potamac High School the weekend of February 16th, 2024, the FMS Caissons brought home another State Champion, Cadet Hunter Wagner. In addition, FMS boasts two State Runner-ups Ryan Barone and Grayson Jones, and a 4th place by Saba Mushkudiani, and a 5th place by Brayden Farrar from the conference. Freshman Larkin Williams in his first year of wrestling lost his first match, then bounced back to win the next three matches before losing in the "blood round." Larkin was one win from securing a state medal. The Caissons finished 26th out of 108 schools competing in the Prep School National Tournament, marking the highest finish in FMS history.

Head Coach and VISAA Wrestling Hall of Famer Terry Waters expressed his gratitude for the season. Waters said, "I owe the parents of the Cadets on the wrestling team for their endless support. And to the seniors whose contributions to the team cannot be measured, and finally, my message to the younger members of the FMS wrestling team— we've only just begun!"

·····Fishburne Middle School - Fall 2024

Fishburne will add a 6th grade in the fall and begin transitioning to Fishburne Middle School (grades 6 – 8) over the next two years. The Fishburne Middle School will be a separate division (non-boarding) and will not be a part

of the Corps of Cadets. The Middle School will feature a classical-style education foundation for boys. The middle school's required uniform will entail Fishburne polo shirts and khaki pants.

For the 2024-2025 school year, the middle school will feature 6th and 7th grades, and for the 2025-2026 school year, an 8th-grade level will be added. The Middle School will be at the First Presbyterian Church on West 11th and Wayne Avenue.

In 2027, 8th graders graduating from the middle school can formally join the Corps of Cadets in the 9th grade to begin their Rook experience.
